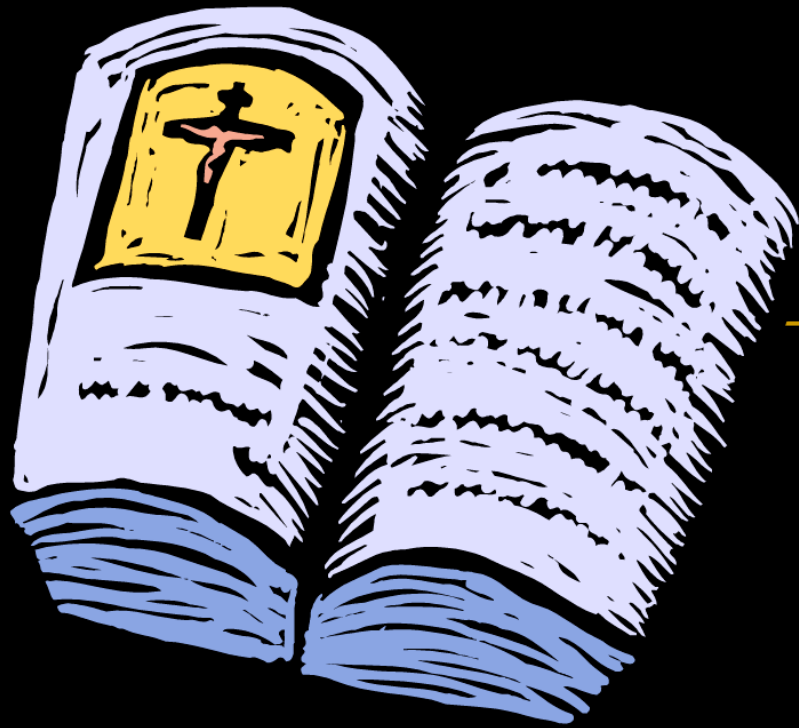

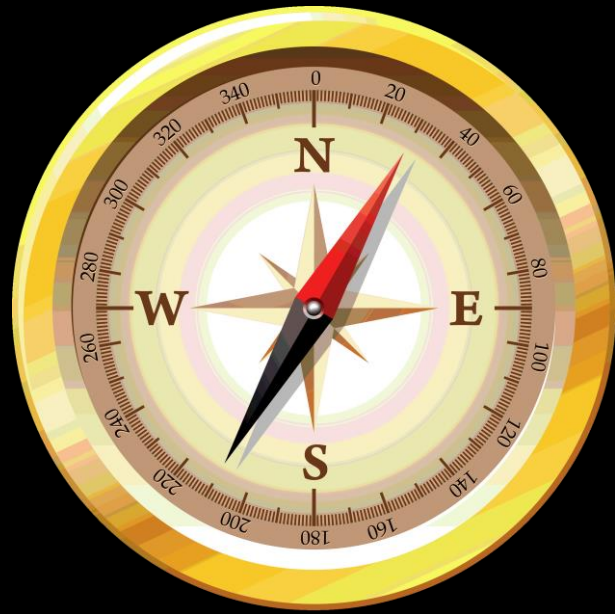

Lesson 1 Scripture

- Isaiah 43:1-7
 - Israel and Judah exhorted not to fear
- *I have redeemed you (v 1)*
- *I love you (v 4)*
- *I am with you (v 5)*
 - Then: No fear for the Babylonian captivity
 - Today: No fear as we are created for His glory—whom He formed and made

Some Facts



- Most Americans (83%) ages 65 and older say they have grandchildren at 50 – 64 it drops to 52%
- More grandparents are living with a grandchild. About 7 million (2013) up from 5.8 million (2000)
- About 10% of all children live in a household with a grandparent
- About one-third of those children also have two parents in the home

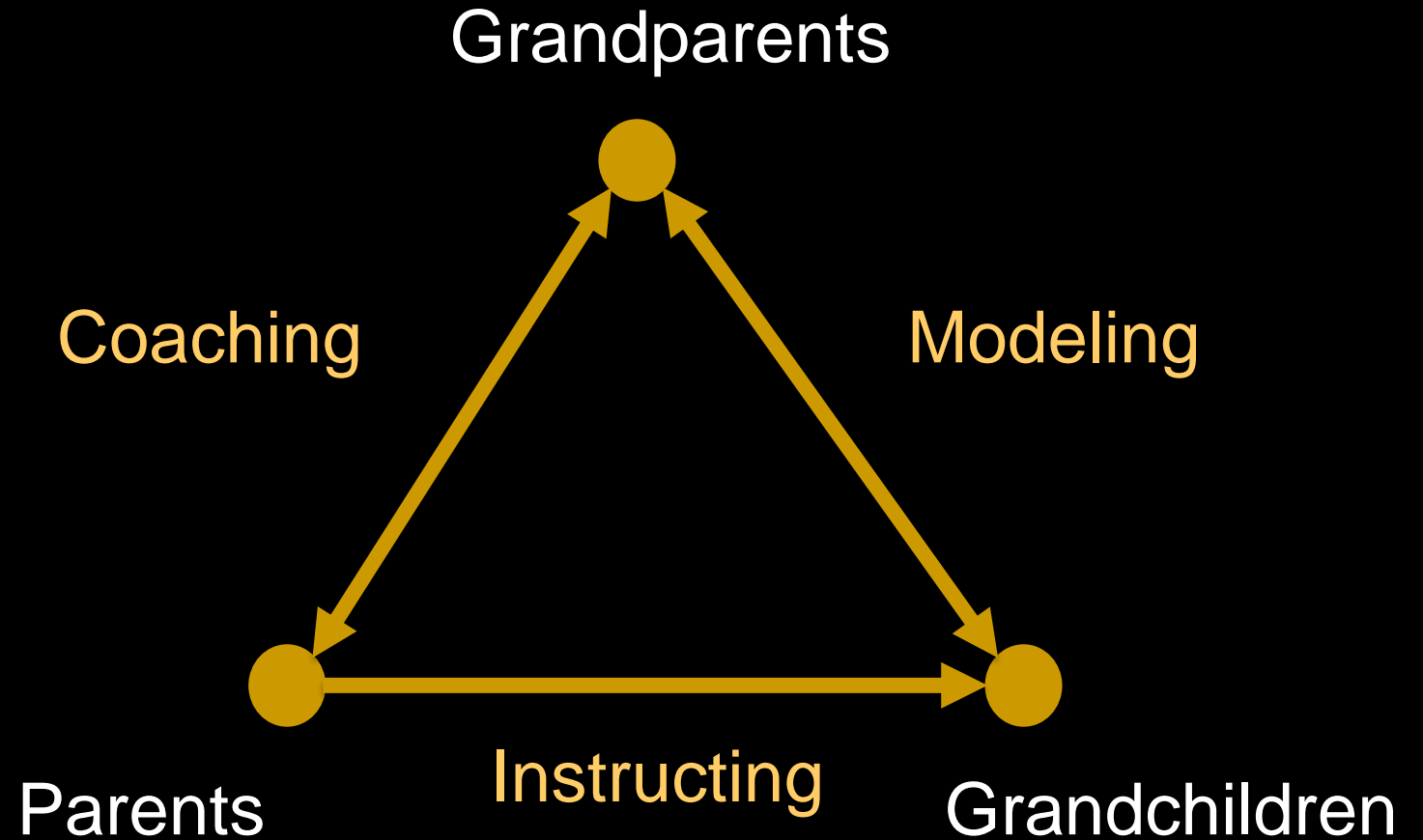
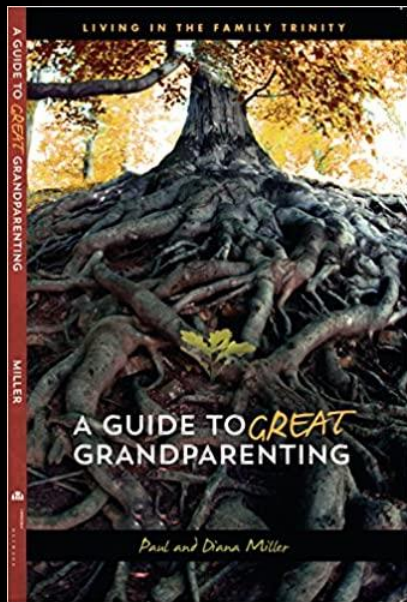
- Over 50% of adult attendees at Immanuel include people 50 years and older

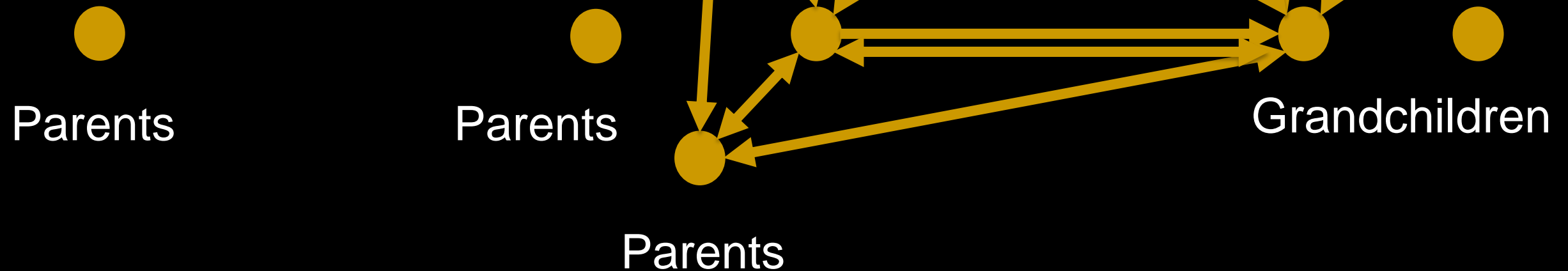
The Family Trinity
